PRESIDENT

It is pleasing to be able to advise SAODC Members that, weather permitting, we have been able to conduct training and Trials as scheduled throughout 2022. That's not to say there have not been difficulties as Instructors, from time to time, had to take time off due to injury, surgery, COVID or long overdue travel.

The Club continued to welcome new members on the last Tuesday of each month in 2022. To assist with class allocations and sometimes limited Instructor numbers, the Club introduced registrations of interest together with the payment of a \$20 deposit. These requirements had no discernible effect on the number of new members. The club welcomed 245 new members and 78 renewals in the 2021/2022 membership year for a total membership of 323. This compares very favourably with the 2020/2021 membership year with 295 new members and 51 renewals (total 346).

On 3 April the Club conducted double Rally and Trick Dog Trials; on 3 October Obedience and Double Trick Dog Trials; and on 5 November Obedience and Trick Dog Trials. The Club also hosted the Obedience Advisory Committee's Stater Obedience and Rally Championships on 17 and 18 September. I extend my appreciation to the Club's retiring Trial Secretary, Vicky Spangler, our Trial Manager, Barbara Richter-Winter, and our Catering Sub-Committee of Deb, Philippa and Jenny, all of whom have ensured the smooth running of our Trials this year.

Thank you to the Club's Committee for all the hard work they do, often behind the scenes, to ensure training and events occurred throughout the year. Special thanks to our Treasurer, Jenny Dunstan, retiring Secretary, Philippa Wishart, and Vice President, Tony Scholefield, for their support this year. I would also like to sincerely thank Ellie Whisson, who resigned from Committee earlier this year due to work commitments, for all her technical knowledge and computing expertise.

The Club's Chief Instructor, Debbie Reid, has been re-elected to this role for 2023. On behalf of the Committee and Instructors I would like to thank her for, yet again, having done a truly excellent

job.

On a sadder note, 2022 saw the passing of two of the Club's stalwarts. The first of these was Club Life Member and Immediate Past Patron, Jack Baker, and, most recently, long time Instructor, Mary Mutch. On behalf of the Club, I extend my condolences to their families and friends.

My best wishes to all our members and their families for the festive season and I hope you all have a happy, safe and peaceful Christmas and New Year. I look forward to seeing everyone back here at the Club in 2023, together with your dogs and puppies ready for another year of fun and training.
