President

It is pleasing to be able to advise SAODC Members that the Club has been able to conduct training and Trials as scheduled throughout 2023 with minimal disruption from the weather or Instructors being unavailable.

The Club continued to welcome new members on the last Tuesday of each month in 2023. To assist with class allocation the Club continued to require registrations of interest together with the payment of a \$20 deposit. The club welcomed 235 new members and 97 renewals in the 2022/2023 membership year for a total membership of 332. This compares very favourably with the 2021/2022 membership year with 245 new members and 78 renewals (total 323). The launch of the Club's new website in early September has enabled the Club to move to on-line membership. This means that new and renewing members will only need to provide evidence of their dog/s' vaccination status prior to commencing or continuing training with the Club.

On 2 April the Club conducted double Rally and Trick Dog Trials; on 1 October Obedience and RallyTrials; and on 4 November Obedience and Trick Dog Trials. The Club also hosted the Obedience Advisory Committee's Stater Obedience and Rally Championships on 16 and 17 September and the Border Collie Club of SA's Obedience, Rally and Trick Dog Trials on 15 October. I extend my appreciation to Barbara Richter-Winter who has very ably combined the roles of Trial Secretary and Trial Manager this year, and our Catering Sub-Committee of Deb and Jenny, all of whom have ensured the smooth running of our Trials this year.

Thank you to the Club's Committee for all the hard work they do, often behind the scenes, to ensure training and events occurred throughout the year. Special thanks to our Treasurer, Jenny Dunstan, Secretary, Tony Scholefield, and Vice President, Chris Oerman, for their support this year. The Club's Chief Instructor, Debbie Reid, has been re-elected to this role for 2024. On behalf of the Committee and Instructors I would like to thank her for, yet again, having done a truly excellent job. During the year the Committee concluded that the ground lights needed to be updated as several areas were becoming quite dim when training at night. Following receipt of several quotes the Committee elected to accept the quote of Rawson's Electrical. Those of you who either train at night or competed at our night trial in November can attest to the improved lighting across the grounds.

On a more annoying note, the clubrooms were also subject to an attempted break-in through the use of an angle grinder on one of the external gates. Although successful in breaching one of the outside gates and damaging the storeroom gate, they were unable to gain access to the clubrooms. The club's insurers have agreed to cover replacement of all external and internal gates as a matter of urgency to ensure security. Committee had already begun negotiations to repair previous more minor damage to the external gates so was able to expedite this arrangement fairly quickly. The new gates and bolted locks are in the process of being installed and finalised.

My best wishes to all our members and their families for the festive season and I hope you all have a happy, safe and peaceful Christmas and New Year. I look forward to seeing everyone back here at the Club in 2024, together with your dogs and puppies ready for another year of fun and training.

Our overall financial position is good for the 2022/23year.
